There will be some adverse effects on portions of the Pearl Harbor Naval Complex, and there will be future Section 106 responsibilities pertaining to the proposed Makalapa Station. Awhile back, Faith Miyamoto told us that such a change to include the Navy as signatories would have to be approved by the Honolulu City Council.
