

Meeting Minutes

Meeting: Hawaii Housing Finance and Development Corporation, 677 Queen Street, Suite 300

Date: October 20, 2008

Purpose: Provide project update to HHFDC and review conceptual design in the vicinity of HHFDC's project site near the intersection of Iwilei Rd/Kaaahi Street Extension and near the intersection of Halekauwila St/Keawe St.

Minutes:

- Clyde Shimizu provided a general project update that included project description and planning/construction schedule.
- Plan and Profiles from drawing that will be included in the Draft EIS and interim draft typical sections were presented.
- Detailed guideway alignment drawings showing column locations and roadway lane configurations were presented.
- Senior Residence at Iwilei. Proposed residential plan improvements do not conflict with proposed transit guideway improvements.
 - Roadway alignment has a 250' radius curve. Guideway proposed to be supported by straddle bents to follow a larger (500' radius) curve radius.
 - Nearest station is just west of site (Iwilei Station).
- Proposed HHFDC project in Kakaako (TMK 2-1-51:009). No issues raised in regard to proposed transit improvements.
 - Guideway supported by straddle bents between South and Cooke Streets. Civic Center Station is east of South St. and placing guideway on straddle bents provides space for parking on each side of Halekauwila Street. In the vicinity of Cooke Street, a large concrete box culvert in the middle of the street eliminates the option of providing columns in the street. Guideway in vicinity of HHFDC's site proposed to be supported on straddle bents to be consistent with guideway sections on either side and to minimize utility relocations.
 - Nearest station is just west of site (Civic Center Station).
