Peter Rogoff asked me to tell everyone working on the Honolulu project: DO NOT give anyone (sponsor, consultants, other agencies, etc.) any estimates of timeframes--for example, for resolution of 106 or FAA matters, for the FEIS issuance, completion of NEPA, etc. Discussion of possible timeframes is strictly for internal use at this time. Please keep this in mind as you are working on the project.
