As a side, any thoughts on your recent meeting with the City in Los Angeles? FAA is planning to provide me a brief and the City is asking to meet with me to brief me as well but I am interested in your perspective as well. I am still curious as to whether the FTA has approved of the City's decision to not go with the avoidance alternative at the airport and Keehi Lagoon Park.
