Toru/Phyllis: I echo Tim's comment that the PMOC schedule noted below is aggressive, but certainly achievable with your continued support of staff attention of the deliverables needed to support our PMOC's work. We do want to get your project into PE, but we must complete this key due diligence product first. The submittal of your ADEIS with a “refreshed” project budget, financial plan, and schedule earlier this month, coupled with the attached letter, triggered our commitment to further address your “project readiness” for entry into this next New Starts phase. Because of the importance of this upcoming workshop in Honolulu, both Leslie and I discussed that maybe a representative from the region should also join Kim Nguyen from our HQ project management group during the week of 9/8. The meetings here in SF this week went so well that we should continue to promote this “face to face” level of communication at particular key milestones as best we can. I'll advise you if Region IX will have a representative there with our team, dependent of travel funds availability.
