According to our real estate people, they have been talking to DLNR Land Division staff about obtaining use of the Aloha Stadium property through an Executive Order. My understanding is that the ownership of the property would remain with the State, but that the Project would be allowed to use the specified property for the specific use described in the Executive Order, subject to cancellation.
