Aloha Stop Rail Now volunteers-

I know it's been a while since you have heard from me. I wanted to update you on a few things, as our fight is far from over.

1. Does anyone have red brochures still? If you do we would like to get them back. You can mail to me at 42 Namala Place, Kailua, 96734. If you have too many to mail send me an e mail and I will figure out how to get them from you. Anyone still have signs? Let me know.

2. COMMENTS regarding the DEIS (Draft Environmental Impact Statement) . Due to the city Director of Transportation Services, with a CC to the FTA and Governor Lingle by Jan. 7. Please let me know if you will help out and send a letter and I will send you the COMPLETE INSTRUCTIONS. These are "letters from the heart", issues that are not adequately addressed in the DEIS, not so technical in nature, such as what this will do to our "Hawaiian Sense of place", a heavy rail system on a tropical island, our tourist industry, etc. (I have a list of about 100 things). VERY IMPORTANT we get a large quantity of letters sent in as they are required to answer them. The instructions at the city's web site do not include sending to the governor, but this is also very important as they need

3. They are once again asking people to attend public meetings to make comments. You will see this on the city web site. We will let you know if we think it is a good idea to attend one of these or better to just write a letter.
