

## Meeting Summary

### West O'ahu Station Group (WOSG) Ho'opili Rail Station Design Community Informational Meeting

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this meeting, a requirement of Stipulation IV of the Section 106 Programmatic Agreement (PA) was to update the community/neighborhood on the design status for the Ho'opili Station.

There were an estimated 25 attendees from the community, project staff and staff from the City's Department of Planning and Permitting.

#### **Introductions**

HART Executive Director and CEO Dan Grabauskas opened the meeting. HART Board Chair, Ivan Lui-Kwan also gave welcoming comments. HART Transit Art Administrator, Lisa Yoshihara provided a powerpoint presentation (Appendix B). Following the presentation was a Q&A session.

#### **General Questions**

1. Will the bus stops be covered?
2. What kind of bus shelters will there be?
3. Will the bus shelters be the same at all stations, or will there be difference between those at transit centers and the neighborhood stations?
4. What kind of pass card will HART use?
5. Will pass cards be the kind you can purchase for a period of time, like a month or year, or will they be rechargeable, so when it gets low, you can put more money on it?
6. Will the kiss and ride be a drop-off where cars line up, which will obstruct traffic, or will there be a loop on the station campus, so the drop-off traffic doesn't back up the street traffic?
7. Will there be bus waiting areas at the neighborhood stations or just in the transit centers?
8. Are stations using renewable energy technologies, like PV solar?
9. Are you going to put PV on station roofs and the platform covers? How about parking areas?
10. What technologies are you considering to improve sustainability of the project?
11. Are you running all the electrical cables through channels and conduits in the guideway segments?
12. Are you using optical fiber?

13. What about future train cars? Will you be able to easily replace the ones you're buying now or will you be stuck with the same manufacturer?
14. What if Ansaldo goes out of business? How will HART replace and upgrade rolling stock?
15. What's the useful life of a train car?
16. What extensions are you planning?
17. What are you going to do to prevent the homeless from congregating at the stations?
18. What are you doing to prevent graffiti and how will you handle it once taggers start spray painting the facilities?
19. How many restrooms will there be at each station?
20. Will you use waterless toilets?
21. Will you use low-flush toilets?
22. Where exactly will the Ala Moana Station be located?
