TRAFFIC ADVISORY: LANE CLOSURES FOR HONOLULU RAIL TRANSIT PROJECT

The Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) wants to inform drivers of lane closures and other traffic changes next week related to design work for the Honolulu rail transit project. Motorists are advised of work in the Pearl Harbor and airport areas that will require lane closures during non-peak traffic hours.

For the safety of both the work crews and motorists, the public is advised to proceed with caution through these areas. Drivers should anticipate possible traffic delays or use alternate routes during work hours, and provide a safe distance between themselves and the workers and equipment.

Lane closures will take place at the following locations from Monday, July 8 to Friday, July 12, between 8:30 a.m. and 3 p.m.:

- **Kamehameha Highway between Arizona Street and Radford Drive in the east-bound direction**
- **Kamehameha Highway between Center Drive and Valkenburgh Street in the west-bound direction**
- **Kamehameha Highway between Radford Drive and Center Drive in the west-bound direction**

Traffic lanes will be adjusted at the following location from Monday, July 8 to Friday, July 12, between 8:30 a.m. and 3 p.m.:

- **Waiwai Loop**

Lane closures, curbside parking restrictions and contraflow lanes will take place at the following location on Saturday, July 13 from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Sunday, July 14 from 9 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.:

- **Waiwai Loop**

Curbside parking will be restricted at the following location from Monday, July 8 to Friday, July 12, from 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.:

- **Along Waiwai Loop**
- **Along Ualena Street**
