HOURS OF OPERATION



The plan right now is to have Honolulu's rail transit system operate 20 hours a day between the hours of 4 a.m. and midnight.

From midnight to 4 a.m., the train cars will be cleaned, maintained and serviced at the rail system's Maintenance and Storage Facility near Leeward Community College.

Between 6 a.m. and 9 a.m., and again between 3 p.m. and 6 p.m., the four-car trains will arrive at each of the rail system's 21 stations every 5 and a half minutes. At all other times, trains are scheduled to arrive about every eleven minutes.

The travel time from end-to-end will be 42 minutes, and this includes stops for boarding and disembarking.

Honolulu's rail system will be a fast and reliable alternative to driving on our city's congested roadways.

100 AND COUNTING



Crews completed work this week on the 100th support column (pictured above) for Honolulu's elevated rail transit system.

This particular milestone column is located along Kualakai Parkway in east Kapolei.

HART expects that by the end of the year, there'll be 220 columns built through Waipahu.

TRAFFIC ALERT



EWA

Farrington Highway between Kualakai Parkway (North-South Road) and Old Fort Weaver Road will be closed overnight Mondays through Fridays from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. for the next month. Motorists should instead use either the H-1 Freeway or Kapolei Parkway.

Left turns from Farrington Highway onto Fort Weaver Road northbound will be restricted 24/7 through July. Eastbound drivers using Farrington Highway in the area will need to take a detour up Leoku Street and use either Leolua Street or Waipahu Street to access Fort Weaver Road.

H-1 WAIAWA INTERCHANGE

Two left southbound lanes of the H-2 Freeway near the H-1/H-2 merge will be closed Sunday, June 15 to Thursday, June 19 between 9 p.m. and 4 a.m.

WAIPAHAU

Westbound lanes of Farrington Highway near Mokuola Street will be closed from Monday, June 16 to Friday, June 20 between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.

One westbound lane of Farrington Highway between Waipahu Depot Road and Aniani Place will be closed from Monday, June 16 to Friday, June 20 between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.

PEARL CITY

Two westbound lanes and one eastbound lane along Kamehameha Highway between Kuala Street and Puu Poni Street will be closed from Monday, June 16 to Friday, June 20 between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. Left turns at the Puu Momi Street intersection will be restricted after 8 p.m. Weekday lane closures will also take place between Puu Poni Street and Kuleana Road between 7 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Two westbound lanes and the eastbound left-turn lanes along Kamehameha Highway will be closed between Puu Poni Street and Kuleana Road from Monday, June 16 to Friday, June 20 between 7 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. and again between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m.

AIEA

The left eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway between Hekaha Street and Kanuku Street near Best Buy is closed 24/7, as is the left eastbound lane between Lipoa Place and Pali Momi Street.

The right eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway between the Moanalua Freeway on-ramp and Salt Lake Boulevard will be closed 24/7 until further notice. One westbound lane of Kamehameha Highway in the same vicinity will be closed between 8:30 a.m. and 3 p.m. and between 7:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. from Monday, June 16 to Friday, June 20.

The right southbound shoulder of Aiea Access Road between Moanalua Road and Kamehameha Highway will be closed from Monday, June 16 to Friday, June 20 between 8:30 a.m. and 3 p.m.

AIRPORT

The left eastbound lane of Aolele Street between the U.S. Post Office and Aopoko Place will be closed from Sunday, June 15 to Thursday June 19 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

KALIHI

Both eastbound and westbound left lanes of Dillingham Boulevard between Kalihi Street and Mokauea Street will be closed from Monday, June 16 to Friday, June 20 between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

DOWNTOWN/KAKAAKO

Left lanes of Nimitz Highway in both directions between Sumner Street and Nuuanu Avenue and the right westbound lane between Punchbowl Street and the Iwilei Road exit will be closed from Sunday, June 15 to Thursday, June 19 between 8:30 p.m. and 4 a.m.

Halekauwila Street in both directions between Richards Street and South Street, the right westbound lane of Kona Street between Piikoi Street and Pensacola Street and the right westbound lane of Waimanu Street between Pensacola Street and Queen Street will be closed from Sunday, June 15 to Thursday, June 19 between 8:30 p.m. and 4 a.m.

Kona Street eastbound and westbound between Piikoi Street and Keeaumoku Street will be closed from Sunday, June 15 to Thursday, June 19 between 8:30 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Halekauwila Street between Coral Street and Cooke Street will be closed in both directions from Sunday, June 15 to Thursday, June 19 between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
