

LUI-KWAN RE-ELECTED HART BOARD CHAIRMAN

The members of the HART Board of Directors yesterday unanimously re-elected Ivan Lui-Kwan to a second term as HART Board Chairman.

Lui-Kwan is an attorney and a former director of the Department of Budget and Fiscal Services for the City and County of Honolulu.

Both men begin serving their new terms July 1.

TRAFFIC ALERT



EWA

Farrington Highway between Kualakai Parkway (North-South Road) and Old Fort Weaver Road will be closed Mondays through Fridays between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. Motorists should instead use either the H-1 Freeway or Kapolei Parkway.

Left turns from Farrington Highway onto Fort Weaver Road northbound will be restricted

24/7 through July. Eastbound drivers using Farrington Highway in the area will need to take a detour up Leoku Street and use either Leolua Street or Waipahu Street to access Fort Weaver Road.

H-1 WAIAWA INTERCHANGE

Two left southbound lanes of the H-2 Freeway near the H-1/H-2 merge will be closed Monday, June 23 to Thursday, June 26 between 9 p.m. and 4 a.m.

WAIPAHU

Westbound lanes of Farrington Highway near the Fort Weaver Road overpass will be closed Monday, June 23 to Friday, June 27 between 10 p.m. and 4 a.m.

Westbound lanes of Farrington Highway near Waipahu Depot Road will be closed from Monday, June 23 to Friday, June 27 between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.

PEARL CITY

Two westbound lanes and two eastbound lanes along Kamehameha Highway between Waiawa Road and Kuleana Road will be closed from Monday, June 23 to Friday, June 27 between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. Left turns at the Puu Momi Street and Waimano Home Road intersections will be restricted after 8 p.m.

One westbound and eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway between Waiawa Road and Waimano Home Road near Home Depot will be closed from Monday, June 23 to Friday, June 27 between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

The inside eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway between Puu Poni Street and Kuleana Road will be closed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

AIEA

The inside eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway between Hekaha Street and Kanuku Street near Best Buy is closed 24/7, as is the left eastbound lane between Lipoa Place and Pali Momi Street. The inside eastbound and westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway between Hekaha Street and Kanuku Street will be closed from Monday, June 23 to Friday, June 27 between 8:30 a.m. and 3 p.m.

The right eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway between the Moanalua Freeway on-ramp and Salt Lake Boulevard will be closed 24/7 until further notice. One westbound lane of Kamehameha Highway in the same vicinity will be closed from Monday, June 23 to Friday, June 27 between 8:30 a.m. and 3 p.m. and between 7:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Aiea Access Road between the Moanalua Freeway on-ramp and Kamehameha Highway near Aloha Stadium will be closed from Monday, June 23 to Friday, June 27 between 10 p.m. and 4 a.m. Southbound traffic will be detoured onto Moanalua Freeway.

AIRPORT

The left eastbound lane of Aolele Street between the U.S. Post Office and Aopoko Place will be closed from Sunday, June 22 to Thursday June 26 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

KALIHI

Kohou Street along the Dillingham Boulevard end of the street will be closed one night only, Monday, June 23 between 8 p.m. and 4 a.m.

DOWNTOWN/KAKAAKO

Kona Street eastbound or westbound between Piikoi Street and Keeaumoku Street will be closed from Sunday, June 22 to Thursday, June 26 between 10 p.m. and 6:30 a.m.
