

Waipahu Depot Street to Mokuola Street

Inside lanes weekdays 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Paiwa Street to Kahualii Street

Left turn eastbound at Kahualii Street 24/7

Inside lanes weekdays 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Kahualii Street to Kamehameha Highway

Outside lanes eastbound weekdays 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY IN PEARL CITY

Waiawa Road to Waimano Home Road

One westbound lane near Acacia Road weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.

One eastbound lane 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

Waiawa Road to Acacia Road

Two westbound left-turn lanes and inside westbound lane 24/7.

One eastbound lane and one eastbound left-turn lane onto Acacia Road fronting Pearl Highlands Center 24/7.

U-turns permitted at the intersection.

Acacia Road to Waimano Home Road

One eastbound left-turn lane onto Waimano Home Road and inside eastbound lane 24/7.

One westbound left-turn lane onto Lehua Avenue and inside westbound lane 24/7.

U-turns at Waimano Home Road intersection permitted.

Waimano Home Road to Puu Momi Street

Inside eastbound lane 24/7 Two eastbound lanes will remain open during peak travel times.

One eastbound lane weeknights 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

One westbound lane weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.

One westbound lane weekdays 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Puu Momi Street to Puu Poni Street

Inside eastbound lane 24/7 between Puu Momi Street and Puu Poni Street for column foundation work with various left turn restrictions. Motorists will be detoured to Puu Poni Street.

Eastbound left turn at Puu Momi will be closed

Puu Poni Street to Kuleana Road

Inside eastbound lane 24/7

Two westbound lanes weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions

One eastbound lane weeknights 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

One westbound lane weekdays 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Lipoa Place to Pali Momi Street

One eastbound and one westbound lane 24/7 with left turn restrictions

Two westbound lanes weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Two eastbound lanes 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

One westbound lane 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Pedestrians detoured to Kaonohi Street

Pali Momi Street to Honomanu Street

One westbound lane 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Two westbound lanes weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Two eastbound lanes 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

Pali Momi Street intersection after 10 p.m.

On 9/3 and 9/4 westbound lanes will be crossed over to the eastbound lanes between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. Local access will be maintained.

Intersection at Kohomua Street weeknights 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY IN PEARL HARBOR/AIRPORT AREAS Kamehameha Highway from Arizona Street to Makalapa Road/Gate

Up to two eastbound lanes 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Kamehameha Highway from Halawa Drive to Radford Drive

One westbound lane 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Westbound bus stop at Kamehameha Highway and Radford Drive temporarily relocated closer to the intersection 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Kamehameha Highway from Center Drive to Radford Drive

One to two westbound lanes 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

The left turn only lane into Makalapa Gate may be routed into the contraflow lane on the opposite side of the median between 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Kamehameha Highway from Makalapa Road to Center Drive

One to two eastbound lanes 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Eastbound bus stop at Kamehameha Highway and Makalapa Rd. temporarily relocated to mid-block 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Makai Frontage Road (off ramp) from Kamehameha Highway/Plantation Drive to Valkenburgh Street

One eastbound lane of Nimitz Highway off ramp closed 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Aolele Street from Aolewa Place to Lagoon Drive

Single westbound lane 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Partial lane closure westbound H-1 onramp 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Keehi Lagoon Park

A section of the road within the park is closed and traffic is detoured to the adjacent parking lot(s) between 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.
