RAIL CAR PRODUCTION UNDERWAY



HART officials this week visited the AnsaldoBreda plant in Pittsburg, California where the first two of the fleet of 80 HART rail cars are undergoing final assembly.

All of the major components for HART's rail cars are right now being manufactured and tested in plants across the mainland U.S.

Each four-car train will have nearly 200 seats and the capacity to carry as many as 800 passengers at a time.

The rail vehicles are due to be delivered to HART's Rail Operations Center in Waipahu within the next six months.

The train cars will then be tested extensively before they are put in service. HART will work to ensure that Honolulu's rail system is fast, reliable, and above all, safe.

GET REVENUE FOR THE QUARTER AT \$64.8 MILLION

The Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) received \$64.8 million in General Excise and Use Tax (GET) surcharge revenue for this past quarter, bringing the total GET collections to date to \$1.58 billion.

The latest GET installment, which covers the months of July, August and September, was \$8.3 million higher than what was estimated for the quarter based on the project's Financial Plan.

Overall GET revenue collections remain \$30.5 million below projections.

The half-percent GET surcharge for Oahu, which by law can only be used for the rail project, began in January 2007.

KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY IN PEARL HARBOR/AIRPORT AREAS

Center Drive to Radford Drive

Two westbound lanes 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

The right turn lane only lane may be closed 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.; right turn allowed at the intersection.

The left turn only lane into Makalapa Gate contraflowed in the eastbound direction 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Radford Drive to Halawa Drive

One lane intermittently 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

The westbound bus stop may be temporarily relocated 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.
