This year, HART wants to help you get there and avoid the hassles of driving and trying to find a place to park.


So once again, HART is offering shoppers a free "Shop, Dine & Shuttle" trolley and mini-bus service circulating between the Aloha Stadium Swap Meet and several shopping centers along Kamehameha Highway in Aiea and Pearl City.

Shop, Dine & Shuttle will run from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturday, December 26.

Every 30 minutes a shuttle vehicle will leave from Aloha Stadium and circulate to nearly a dozen shopping destinations on Kamehameha Highway, including Pearlridge Center, Waimalu Shopping Center, Pearl Highlands and Pearl Kai Shopping Center.

So do your after-Christmas shopping and leave the driving to us while supporting our local businesses.

HART BUSINESS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM



During the 2015 holiday season, the following adjusted lane closure schedule will be in effect for Farrington and Kamehameha Highways:

NO ROADWORK/LANE CLOSURES*

December 24 through 27 and December 31 through January 3

MODIFIED ROADWORK/LANE CLOSURES*

The modified schedule is as follows through January 3:

For Farrington Highway

Daytime No daytime closures

Nighttime: 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

For Kamehameha Highway

Daytime: No daytime closures

Nighttime: Eastbound direction - 10 pm. to 5:30 a.m.

Westbound direction - 10 p.m. to 8 a.m.

*All 24/7 closures currently in place will remain in place during this time frame. All regular lane closure hours will resume on Monday, January 4, 2016.
