

Hawaiian Electric Company Utilities Work on Kamehameha Highway

Location: Westbound Kamehameha Highway between Aiea Access Road off-ramp and the westbound Moanalua Freeway off-ramp (see map below, area marked is location of closure).

Subject: Overnight Westbound Lane Closure for Utilities Infrastructure Work


Timeframe: Saturday, August 13, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. to Sunday, August 14, 2016 at 7:00 a.m.

Hawaiian Electric Company crews will be performing utilities infrastructure work along Kamehameha Highway as part of the Honolulu Rail Transit Project. For safety, westbound Kamehameha Highway between the Aiea Access Road off-ramp and the westbound Moanalua Freeway off-ramp will be closed for one night from 7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.

A signed detour will be in place directing traffic north to Aiea Access Road, west to Moanalua Road, and south to Laulima Street for access to areas and businesses between westbound Moanalua Freeway off-ramp and Honomanu Street.

There will be no customer outages associated with this work.

Hawaiian Electric Company crews will return to the area at the end of August and perform additional work through to the end of the year. Please check WWW.HONOLULUTRANSIT.ORG for details.
