The Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) will hold the latest in a series of community meetings tomorrow (Thursday), November 21, to discuss designs for the rail stations in the Pearl Harbor and Mapunapuna areas.

The meeting at the Moanalua High School cafeteria at 2825 Ala Ilima Street will focus on the Pearl Harbor Naval Base, Lagoon Drive and Middle Street rail stations. Registration is at 6 p.m. with the meeting starting at 6:30 p.m.

HART Executive Director and CEO Dan Grabauskas will be joined at the meeting by Honolulu Mayor Kirk Caldwell, HART board chairman Ivan Lui-Kwan, and HART's project team.

Those who attend will be able to view updated rail station designs and share their ideas and feedback on the stations and related cultural and art programs.

Community meetings have already been held to gather feedback on designs for the West Oahu, Waipahu, Pearl City and Aiea region stations. Meetings for other regional station groups in the urban Honolulu area are scheduled for next year.
