Subject: Notice of Award for Section 106 Programmatic Agreement Project Manager/Kakoo for the Honolulu Rail Transit Project

In March 2012, Pacific Legacy, Inc. was awarded the contract for the Section 106 Programmatic Agreement Project Manager or Kakoo for the Honolulu Rail Transit Project. This action fulfills the terms and conditions of Stipulation 1. Roles and Responsibilities, Section H. of the Section 106 Programmatic Agreement for the Honolulu High Capacity Transit Corridor Project.

Pacific Legacy, Inc. will assist with the coordination of all reviews and deliverables required under the terms and conditions of the Programmatic Agreement. Pacific Legacy, Inc. staff and team members meet the Secretary of the Interior's Professional Qualification Standards set forth in 36 CFR part 61, regarding qualification for preservation professionals in the areas of history, archaeology, architectural history, architecture or historic architecture. Pacific Legacy, Inc. was incorporated in 1994 and has 18 years of experience in conducting archaeological and historic preservation studies in Hawaii and the Pacific. Pacific Legacy, Inc. staff and team members include two architectural historians, two historic archaeologists, two pre-contact archaeologists, and two Section 106 specialists. Pursuant to the PA, the request for proposal was released to the General Public on or after May 20, 2011 (published in the Star Advertiser on May 27 and May 29, 2011, and posted on the National Trust for Historic Preservation website on May 20, 2011, posted on PreserveNet on

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May 20, 2011, posted on the City's Budget and Fiscal Services – Division of Purchasing website on May 20, 2011). Pacific Legacy, Inc. was awarded the Section 106 Programmatic Agreement Project Manager Professional Service Contract. The Evaluation Committee was comprised of HART staff, HART's General Engineering Consultant staff, and the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State Historic Preservation Division (SHPD) staff. The Scope of Work for the Kakoo is defined in the Programmatic Agreement, and was included in the City's contract with the selected firm to ensure the duties and responsibilities are consistent with the Programmatic Agreement.

Pursuant to the Programmatic Agreement under Stipulation 1. Section H, HART is providing this written notification to the Federal Transit Administration, SHPD, the Programmatic Agreement Signatories and Consulting Parties, that Pacific Legacy, Inc. has been awarded the Section 106 Programmatic Agreement Project Manager/Kakoo contract.
