

Airport Traffic Update | Week of July 28, 2013

The Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) wants to inform drivers of weekly lane closures related to design work for the Honolulu rail transit project. Motorists are advised of work in the Pearl Harbor and airport areas that will require lane closures during non-peak traffic hours.

For the safety of both the work crews and motorists, the public is advised to proceed with caution through these areas. Drivers should anticipate possible traffic delays or use alternate routes during work hours, and provide a safe distance between themselves and the workers and equipment.

Lane closures will take place from Monday, July 29 to Friday, August 2 between 8:30 a.m. and 3 p.m. at the following location:

- **The left lane of Kamehameha Highway in the east-bound direction between Arizona Street and Radford Drive**
