EMBOSSED COLUMNS IN EAST KAPOELI



With the addition of the embossed columns for the rail station to be built in east Kapolei near the Kroc Center, HART has now completed the aesthetic columns for the three stations at the ewa end of the rail alignment.

The design of the east Kapolei station aesthetic columns celebrates the significance of *Puu o Kapolei* to Hawaiian agriculture. When the sun set behind this hill, it marked the winter and summer solstices and the change of seasons. Ancient Hawaiian farmers used the signs to aid them in the planting and harvesting of their crops.

Hala trees were plentiful in the Honouliuli ahupuaa, and the fruit was used to fashion a lei for Kapo, goddess of hula and sister of Pele.

Kapolei translates as the lei of Kapo, or beloved Kapolei.

Construction crews earlier completed work on the aesthetic columns for the UH-West Oahu and Hoopili stations.

One westbound left-turn lane and inside westbound lane 24/7.

Acacia Road to Waimano Home Road

One eastbound left-turn lane onto Waimano Home Road and inside eastbound lane 24/7.

One westbound left-turn lane onto Lehua Avenue and inside westbound lane 24/7.

U-turns at Waimano Home Road intersection permitted.

Puu Momi Street to Kuleana Road

Inside eastbound lane 24/7

Two westbound lanes weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Inside westbound lane 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Waiawa Road to Waimano Home Road

One westbound lane near Acacia Road weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.

One eastbound lane 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

Waimano Home Road to Puu Momi Street

Inside eastbound lane 24/7 Two eastbound lanes will remain open during peak travel times.
