## RAIL OPERATIONS CENTER PROGRESS



Work at HART's Rail Operations Center in Waipahu is now nearly 80 percent complete.

And early next year the Center will be ready for the delivery and testing of HART's first train cars.

Much of the remaining work at the 43-acre site that sits between the football field at Waipahu High School and the parking lots at Leeward Community College is taking place inside the main buildings.

Those include the Operations and Servicing Building where workers will perform maintenance on the train vehicles.

It will also house the computerized control center where operators will run and monitor Honolulu's fully-automated rail system.

Look for work to be completed in the first half of the new year.

## FARRINGTON HIGHWAY IN KAPOLEI/EWA

Kualakai Parkway to Old Fort Weaver Road Loop  
Beginning Monday, October 5 and running through Friday, October 9 one lane will be open on Farrington Highway 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and traffic will alternate between westbound and eastbound flow at regular intervals managed by flaggers at each end of the closures  
7:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. weeknights

## H-1 FREEWAY WAIAWA INTERCHANGE

H-1 westbound Waipahu off-ramp 9 p.m. to 4 a.m. Sunday night through Friday morning and from  
8 p.m. next Friday, October 9 to 8 a.m. on Saturday, October 10 and from 8 p.m. Saturday, October 10 to 10 a.m. Sunday, October 11.

### KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY IN PEARL HARBOR/AIRPORT AREAS

Center Drive to Radford Drive

Two westbound lanes between 8:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.

Right turn lane only lane may be closed between 8:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.; right turn allowed at the intersection.

Left turn only lane into Makalapa Gate contraflowed in the eastbound direction between 8:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.

Radford Drive to Halawa Drive

One lane between 8:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.

Westbound bus stop is temporarily relocated between 8:00 am and 2:30 p.m.

Arizona Memorial Place to Arizona Street
