RAIL CONSTRUCTION UPDATE



Construction of the Honolulu rail system continues to progress at a steady pace.

Between east Kapolei and into Waipahu, nearly all of the underground foundations are in place. Crews continue to erect columns and build the elevated guideway.

Along Kamehameha Highway nearly a dozen columns have now been built. Work on foundations and utility relocation work continues in other areas along the corridor.



And at the Rail Operations Center, work is now nearly 85 percent complete. Most of the buildings on the 43-acre site in Waipahu are scheduled for completion by the end of the year. And the base yard should be done early next year, in time for the delivery of HART's first rail cars.

EAST KAPOLEI/EWA (FARRINGTON HIGHWAY)

Kualakai Parkway (North-South Road) to Old Fort Weaver Road
Farrington Highway between Kualakai Parkway (North-South Road) and Old Fort Weaver Road Loop is closed:

Weeknights between 7:30 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Westbound lanes closed 24/7

H-1 FREEWAY WAIAWA INTERCHANGE

H-1 Freeway Waipahu off-ramp

Westbound Waipahu off-ramp 9 p.m. to 4 a.m. nightly beginning Sunday night and concluding Friday morning.

Community College entrance

Closed westbound lanes of Farrington Highway near Waiawa Road will be crossed over to the eastbound side from 8 p.m. to 4 a.m. nightly beginning Sunday night through Friday morning and from from 8 p.m. tonight, Friday, November 6 to 8 a.m. Saturday, November 7 and from 8 p.m. Saturday, November 7 to 10 a.m. Sunday, November 8. The Farrington Highway eastbound on-ramp to the H-1 Freeway eastbound will be closed Sunday through Thursday night from 9 p.m. to 4 a.m.

WAIPAHU (FARRINGTON HIGHWAY)

Farrington Highway through Waipahu

Single outside lanes along Farrington Highway closed at various locations for utility relocation work between 7 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Fort Weaver Road Overpass at Farrington Highway

- Southbound lanes of the Fort Weaver Road overpass will be closed nightly from Sunday, November 8 to Thursday, November 12 between 9 p.m. and 4 a.m. Northbound lanes will be closed overnight for 4 days beginning next Sunday, November 15.

Old Fort Weaver Road to Leoku Street

- The inside lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Leoku Street to Leokane Street

- Inside lanes of Farrington Highway closed 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. weekdays and Saturdays as needed.
- The eastbound lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed from 7 p.m to 6 a.m.
- Left turns from Farrington Highway westbound at Leoku Street will be closed 24/7.

Leokane to Pupukahi Street

- The inside lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. weekdays and Saturday as needed.

Pupukahi to Pupupuhi Street

- The inside lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m weekdays and Saturday as needed.

Pupupuhi Street to Aniani Place

- Left turns from Farrington Highway to Aniani Place / Waikele Road will be closed 24/7
- Inside lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

The Aniani Place intersection will be closed 24/7 from Thursday, November 12 to Sunday, November 15. No left turns at the Aniani Place intersection. No northbound/southbound traffic crossing Farrington Highway at the Aniani Place intersection. One lane open in each direction on Farrington Highway at Aniani Place.

Aniani Place to Waipahu Depot Street

- Inside lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Waipahu Depot Street to Mokuola Street

- The inside lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Left turn from Farrington Highway eastbound at Mokuola Street will be closed 24/7

Paiwa Street to Kahualii Street

- Left turn on Farrington Highway eastbound at Kahualii Street closed 24/7.
- Left turns of Farrington Highway westbound at Kahualii Street closed 9 a.m. to 5:30 a.m. the following morning.
- Eastbound traffic will be contraflowed at the Kahualii Street intersection. One lane will remain open in each direction during non-peak travel times.
- A temporary eastbound lane will provide two lanes of travel Monday through Friday from 6 a.m. to 9 a.m.
- No left turns and no northbound/southbound traffic crossing Farrington Highway at the Kahualii Street intersection from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday to Friday starting Wednesday, November 11.
- The eastbound lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed from 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

PEARL CITY (KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY)

Waiawa Road to Acacia Road

- One straight-through eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed 24/7
- One westbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Two westbound left turn lanes and a single inside lane westbound will be closed 24/7. Two through lanes will remain open.

Acacia Road to Waimano Home Road

- One straight-through lane of Kamehameha Highway in both directions and one left-turn lane in each direction onto Waimano Home Road and Lehua Avenue closed 24/7.
- One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed from 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- One westbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.

Waimano Home Road to Puu Momi Street

- Inside eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed 24/7 between Waimano Home Road and Puu Momi Street through mid-2016 for column foundation work.
- Two eastbound lanes will remain open during peak travel times.

- One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- Two westbound lanes will be closed 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.

Puu Momi Street to Puu Poni Street

- Inside eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed 24/7 with various left turn restrictions.
- Two eastbound and two westbound lanes will remain open during peak travel times.

Puu Poni Street to Kuleana Road

- Inside eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed 24/7 through mid-2016 for column foundation work.
- One westbound lane closed overnight between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.
- One eastbound lane closed 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- Left turn at Kuleana Road is closed. Motorists will be detoured to Kaahumanu Street
- One west bound lane closed 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Kuleana Road to Kaonohi Street

- One inside lane of Kamehameha Highway eastbound and one inside lane westbound will be closed 24/7 between Kuleana Road and Kaahumanu Street with various left turn restrictions.
- Left turn westbound at Kaluamoi Place will be closed. Westbound motorists will be detoured to Kuleana Road. Eastbound motorists will be detoured to Kaahumanu Street.
- One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed from 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- One westbound lane will be closed 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.

Kanuku Street to Kaonohi Street

One inside lane of Kamehameha Highway eastbound and one inside lane in the westbound direction will be closed 24/7 between. Left turn restrictions will be in place.

AIEA/ALOHA STADIUM (KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY)

Lipoa Place to Pali Momi Street

- Two westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.
- Two eastbound lanes closed between 7 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Pali Momi Street to Honomanu Street

- Two westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- Two eastbound lanes closed between 7 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Various left turn pocket restrictions will be in place.

Near Aloha Stadium -Honomanu Street to Salt Lake Boulevard

- The Kamehameha Highway westbound on-ramp to the Moanalua Freeway will be closed 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday night through Thursday night
- Up to three westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. Various left turn restrictions in place.
- Two eastbound lanes closed between 7 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.
- Up to three westbound lanes of Salt Lake Boulevard will be closed from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be crossed over to the westbound lanes between 8 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

PEARL HARBOR/AIRPORT

(NOTE: There'll be no lane closures in the Pearl Harbor/Airport area on Wednesday, November 11, in observance of the Veterans' Day holiday.

Kamehameha Highway from Center Drive to Radford Drive

- Two westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.
- The right turn lane only lane may be closed between 8:00 a.m. and 2:30p.m.; right turn allowed at the intersection.
- The left turn only lane into Makalapa Gate is contraflowed in the eastbound direction between 8:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.

Kamehameha Highway from Radford Drive to Halawa Drive

- Two lanes of Kamehameha Highway may be closed 8:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. with traffic contraflowed to the eastbound lane just beyond the Radford intersection.
- The westbound bus stop at Radford Drive may be temporarily relocated closer to the intersection between 8:00 am and 2:30 p.m.
- One lane of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. approaching Halawa Drive.

Kamehameha Highway from Arizona Memorial Place to Arizona Street

- One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Kamehameha Highway from Arizona Street to Makalapa Road/Gate

- Two eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Kamehameha Highway from Makalapa Road to Center Drive

- One to two eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
- Eastbound bus stop at Kamehameha Highway and Makalapa Rd. may be temporarily relocated to mid-block between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Makai Frontage Road/Nimitz Hwy Eastbound from Kamehameha Highway/Plantation Drive to H-1/Valkenburgh Street/Hickam AFB

- Single eastbound lane approaching H-1/ Nimitz Highway closed between 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.
- Single eastbound right lane approaching Hickam AFB may be closed between 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.

Aolele Street from Aolewa Place to Lagoon Drive

- Single westbound lane is closed between 8:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
