
HART is encouraging people to support their local businesses during rail construction. The merchants are offering special deals and discounts for shoppers.

### **EAST KAPOLEI/EWA (FARRINGTON HIGHWAY)**

Kualakai Parkway (North-South Road) to Old Fort Weaver Road  
Farrington Highway between Kualakai Parkway (North-South Road) and Old Fort Weaver Road Loop:

- Westbound lanes closed 24/7

### **H-1 FREEWAY WAIAWA INTERCHANGE**

H-1 Freeway Waipahu off-ramp

- Westbound Waipahu off-ramp 9 p.m. to 4 a.m. beginning Sunday night and concluding Saturday morning

Farrington Highway near Leeward Community College entrance

- Closed westbound lanes of Farrington Highway near Waiawa Road crossed over to the eastbound side 8 p.m. to 4 a.m. nightly beginning Sunday night through Thursday morning.
- Farrington Highway eastbound on-ramp to the H-1 Freeway eastbound Sunday through Thursday nights 9 p.m. to 4 a.m.

### **WAIPAHU (FARRINGTON HIGHWAY)**

Farrington Highway through Waipahu

- Single outside lanes 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Fort Weaver Road Overpass at Farrington Highway

- Northbound lanes of Fort Weaver Road overpass closed nightly from

Sunday, November 15 to Thursday, November 19 between 8 p.m. and 4 a.m

Old Fort Weaver Road to Leoku Street

- Inside lanes 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Left turns from Farrington Highway eastbound to Fort Weaver Road 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Leoku Street to Leokane Street

- Outside lane 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. weekdays and Saturdays as needed.
- The eastbound lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Leokane to Pupukahi Street

- Inside lanes 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. weekdays and Saturday as needed.

Pupukahi to Pupupuhi Street

- Inside lanes 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Pupupuhi Street to Aniani Place

- Inside lanes 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

INTERSECTION CLOSURE AT ANIANI PLACE - THROUGH SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 15

- No left turns from Farrington Highway to Aniani Place or Waikele Road
- No crossing Farrington Highway through the intersection
- Inside lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed

Aniani Place to Waipahu Depot Street

- Inside lanes westbound 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Westbound lanes 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Left turns from Farrington Highway westbound at Aniani Place 24/7.

Waipahu Depot Street to Mokuola Street

- Inside lanes 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Left turn from Farrington Highway eastbound at Mokuola Street closed 24/7
- Right turn lane from Waipahu Depot Street to Farrington Highway eastbound will be shifted to the left.

Paiwa Street to Kahualii Street

INTERSECTION CLOSURE AT KAHUALII STREET (THROUGH NOVEMBER 20)

- The intersection at Kahualii Street will be closed tomorrow, Saturday, 11/14 from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Drivers will be detoured to Paiwa Street. And Monday to Friday from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Only eastbound and westbound traffic permitted at Kahualii Street. Right turns will remain open.
- Left turns will be restricted from Farrington Highway westbound to Waipio Point Access Road from 9 a.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning.
- Eastbound lanes of Farrington Highway between Paiwa Street and Kahualii Street will be closed from 7 p.m. to 7:30 a.m.
- Left turns from Farrington Highway eastbound at Kahualii will be restricted 24/7.

Kahualii Street to Kamehameha Highway Overpass

- The outside lane of Farrington Highway eastbound will be closed 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

**PEARL CITY (KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY)**

Waiawa Road to Acacia Road

- One straight-through eastbound lane 24/7
- One westbound lane 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Two westbound left turn lanes and a single inside lane westbound 24/7.

Acacia Road to Waimano Home Road

- One straight-through lane in both directions and one left-turn lane in each direction onto Waimano Home Road and Lehua Avenue 24/7.
- One eastbound lane 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- One westbound lane 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.

Waimano Home Road to Puu Momi Street

- Inside eastbound lane 24/7
- Two eastbound lanes will remain open during peak travel times.
- One eastbound lane 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- Two westbound lanes 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.

Puu Momi Street to Puu Poni Street

- Inside eastbound lane 24/7 with various left turn restrictions

Puu Poni Street to Kuleana Road

- Inside eastbound lane 24/7
- One westbound lane 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.
- One eastbound lane 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- One westbound lane 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Kuleana Road to Kaonohi Street

- One inside lane of Kamehameha Highway eastbound and one inside lane westbound will be closed 24/7 between Kuleana Road and Kaahumanu Street with various left turn restrictions.
- Left turn eastbound at Kaahumanu Street will be temporarily closed. Eastbound motorists will be detoured to Kuleana Road and Hekaha Street.
- One eastbound lane 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- One westbound lane 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.

Kanuku Street to Kaonohi Street

One inside lane eastbound and one inside lane westbound 24/7 with left turn restrictions

**AIEA/ALOHA STADIUM (KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY)**

Lipoa Place to Pali Momi Street

- Two westbound lanes 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.
- Two eastbound lanes 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

#### Pali Momi Street to Honomanu Street

- Two westbound lanes 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Two eastbound lanes 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. with various left turn pocket restrictions

#### Near Aloha Stadium -Honomanu Street to Salt Lake Boulevard

- The Kamehameha Highway westbound on-ramp to the Moanalua Freeway 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday night through Thursday night
- Up to three westbound lanes 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Various left turn restrictions in place.
- Two eastbound lanes 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- Up to three westbound lanes of Salt Lake Boulevard 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be crossed over to the westbound lanes between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.

### **PEARL HARBOR/AIRPORT**

#### Kamehameha Highway from Center Drive to Radford Drive

- Two westbound lanes 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.; right turn allowed at the intersection.
- The right turn lane only lane may be closed between 8 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.
- The left turn only lane into Makalapa Gate is contraflowed in the eastbound direction between 8 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.

#### Kamehameha Highway from Radford Drive to Halawa Drive

- Two lanes may be closed 8 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. with traffic contraflowed to the eastbound lane just beyond the Radford intersection.
- The westbound bus stop at Radford Drive may be temporarily relocated closer to the intersection between 8:00 am and 2:30 p.m.
- One lane closed 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. approaching Halawa Drive.

#### Kamehameha Highway from Ford Island Bridge to Arizona Memorial Place

- Two eastbound lanes 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

#### Kamehameha Highway from Arizona Memorial Place to Arizona Street

- One eastbound lane 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

#### Kamehameha Highway from Arizona Street to Makalapa Road/Gate

- Two eastbound lanes 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

#### Kamehameha Highway from Makalapa Road to Center Drive

- One to two eastbound lanes 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Eastbound bus stop at Kamehameha Highway and Makalapa Rd. may be temporarily relocated to mid-block 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

#### Makai Frontage Road/Nimitz Hwy Eastbound from Kamehameha Highway/Plantation Drive to H-1/Valkenburgh Street/Hickam AFB

- Single eastbound lane approaching H-1/ Nimitz Highway 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.
- Single eastbound right lane approaching Hickam AFB may be closed 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Aolele Street from Aolewa Place to Lagoon Drive

- Single westbound lane 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
