THANKSGIVING HOLIDAY TRAFFIC INFORMATION



Good news for motorists, holiday shoppers and business owners.

HART will limit lane closures along Kamehameha Highway through Aiea and Pearl City and on Farrington Highway through Waipahu on the Wednesday before Thanksgiving, Thanksgiving Day and Black Friday, November 25, 26 and 27. The move will allow traffic to flow more freely day and night during one of the busiest holiday shopping times of the year.

Additionally, the left turn into the Home Depot parking lot from westbound Kamehameha Highway at Acacia Road, which has been closed, will be temporarily reopened to allow customers easy access to the business over the shopping weekend.

Crews will work their regular schedules along Farrington Highway and Kamehameha Highway early during the Thanksgiving week, and those lanes and highways that have been closed 24/7 will remain closed throughout the Thanksgiving holiday period. HART will provide notification should there be any change in the schedule.

Construction crews will resume their regular work schedule on Monday, November 30.

Similar adjustments to lane closures are also planned for the period from December 11 through January 3, 2016.

STATION CONSTRUCTION BID RESULTS



Four construction companies submitted bids this week to build the three rail stations at Pearl Highlands, Pearlridge and Aloha Stadium.

Watts Constructors had the apparent low bid of \$112,724,335. HART is now in the process of evaluating the bids.

Other companies that submitted bids were Nan, Inc., Hawaiian Dredging Construction Company and Hensel Phelps.

The three stations in the Pearl City area were originally included in a nine-station package that came in well over HART's budgeted projections. HART cancelled the solicitation.

In repackaging the station construction work into three smaller packages, HART was able to save more than \$40 million.

H-1 FREEWAY WAIAWA INTERCHANGE

H-1 Freeway Waipahu off-ramp

- Westbound Waipahu off-ramp closed 9 p.m. to 4 a.m. nightly.

Farrington Highway near Leeward Community College entrance

- Up to three outside lanes of the H-2 Freeway westbound will be closed from 9 p.m. to 4 a.m.
- Closed westbound lanes of Farrington Highway near Waiawa Road will be crossed over to the eastbound side from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. nightly beginning Sunday night through Wednesday morning and from 8 p.m. tonight to 4 a.m. Saturday, November 21 and from 8 p.m. Saturday, November 21 to 10 a.m. Sunday, November 22.
- The Farrington Highway eastbound on-ramp to the H-1 Freeway eastbound will be closed Sunday through Wednesday from 9 p.m. to 4 a.m.

WAIPAHU (FARRINGTON HIGHWAY)

Farrington Highway through Waipahu

- Single outside lanes along Farrington Highway closed at various locations for utility relocation work between 7 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Old Fort Weaver Road to Leoku Street

The outside lane of Farrington Highway will be closed from 8:30 a.m. to

3:30 p.m.

- Left turns from Farrington Highway eastbound to Fort Weaver Road will be closed from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Leoku Street to Leokane Street

- The inside lanes of Farrington Highway closed 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. weekdays and Saturdays as needed.
- Left turn from Farrington Highway westbound at Leoku Street will be closed.
- The right turn from Farrington Highway westbound at Leoku Street will be shifted to the left. eastbound lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Aniani Place to Waipahu Depot Street

- Inside lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Westbound lanes of Farrington Highway closed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured to eastbound lanes.

Waipahu Depot Street to Mokuola Street

- The inside lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Westbound lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Traffic will be detoured to Hikimoe Street.

Paiwa Street to Kahualii Street

INTERSECTION CLOSURE AT KAHUALII STREET (THROUGH NOVEMBER 23)

- The intersection at Kahualii Street will be closed Monday, November 23, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Traffic will be detoured to Paiwa Street. Only eastbound and westbound traffic permitted at Kahualii Street. Right turns will remain open.
- Left turns will be restricted from Farrington Highway westbound to Waipio Point Access Road from 9 a.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning.
- Eastbound lanes of Farrington Highway between Paiwa Street and Kahualii Street will be closed from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

PEARL CITY (KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY)

Waiawa Road to Acacia Road

- One straight-through eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed 24/7
- One westbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- One westbound left turn lane and a single inside lane westbound will be closed 24/7. Two through lanes will remain open, and one left turn lane into the Home Depot parking lot will be open beginning Wednesday, November 25 through the

Thanksgiving holiday.

Acacia Road to Waimano Home Road

- One straight-through lane of Kamehameha Highway in both directions and one left-turn lane in each direction onto Waimano Home Road and Lehua Avenue closed 24/7.
- One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed from 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- One westbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.

Waimano Home Road to Puu Momi Street

- Inside eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed 24/7 between Waimano Home Road and Puu Momi Street through mid-2016 for column foundation work.
- Two eastbound lanes will remain open during peak travel times.
- One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- One westbound lane will be closed 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.

Puu Momi Street to Puu Poni Street

- Inside eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed 24/7 with various left turn restrictions.
- Two eastbound and two westbound lanes will remain open during peak travel times.

Puu Poni Street to Kuleana Road

- Inside eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed 24/7 through mid-2016 for column foundation work.
- One westbound lane closed overnight between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.
- One eastbound lane closed 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- One west bound lane closed 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Kuleana Road to Kaahumanu Street

- One inside lane of Kamehameha Highway eastbound and one inside lane westbound will be closed 24/7 between Kuleana Road and Kaahumanu Street with various left turn restrictions.
- Westbound left turn at Kaluamoi Place will be closed. Westbound motorists will be detoured to Kuleana Road.
- One left turn eastbound at Kaahuman Street will be temporarily closed.
- One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed from 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- One westbound lane will be closed 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.

Kanuku Street to Kaonohi Street

One inside lane of Kamehameha Highway eastbound and one inside lane in the westbound direction will be closed 24/7 between. Left turn restrictions will be in place.

AIEA/ALOHA STADIUM (KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY)
Lipoa Place to Pali Momi Street

- Two westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.
- Two eastbound lanes closed between 7 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Pali Momi Street to Honomanu Street

- Two westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- Two eastbound lanes closed between 7 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Various left turn pocket restrictions will be in place.

Near Aloha Stadium -Honomanu Street to Salt Lake Boulevard

- The Kamehameha Highway westbound on-ramp to the Moanalua Freeway will be closed 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday night through Wednesday
- Up to three westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. Various left turn restrictions in place.
- Two eastbound lanes closed between 7 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.
- Up to three westbound lanes of Salt Lake Boulevard will be closed from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be crossed over to the westbound lanes between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m.

PEARL HARBOR/AIRPORT

Monday through Friday lane closures (No roadwork Thursday and Friday, November 26 & 27)

Kamehameha Highway from Center Drive to Radford Drive

- Two westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.; right turn allowed at the intersection.
- The right turn lane only lane may be closed between 8 a.m. and 2:30p.m.
- The left turn only lane into Makalapa Gate is contraflowed in the eastbound direction between 8 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.

Kamehameha Highway from Radford Drive to Halawa Drive

- Two lanes of Kamehameha Highway may be closed 8 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. with traffic contraflowed to the eastbound lane just beyond the Radford intersection.
- The westbound bus stop at Radford Drive may be temporarily relocated closer to the intersection between 8 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.
- One lane of Kamehameha Highway may be closed between 8 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. approaching Halawa Drive.

Kamehameha Highway from Ford Island Bridge to Arizona Memorial Place

- One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway may be closed between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Kamehameha Highway from Arizona Memorial Place to Arizona Street

- One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Kamehameha Highway from Arizona Street to Makalapa Road/Gate

- Two eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Kamehameha Highway from Makalapa Road to Center Drive

- One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
- Eastbound bus stop at Kamehameha Highway and Makalapa Rd. may be temporarily relocated to mid-block between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Makai Frontage Road/Nimitz Hwy Eastbound from Kamehameha Highway/Plantation Drive to H-1/Valkenburgh Street/Hickam AFB

- Single eastbound lane approaching H-1/ Nimitz Highway closed between 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.
- Single eastbound right lane approaching Hickam AFB may be closed between 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.

Monday through Friday lane closures (No roadwork Thursday, November 27)

Aolele Street from Aolewa Place to Lagoon Drive

- Single westbound lane is closed between 8:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
