HART LAUNCHES HOLIDAY SHOPPING SHUTTLE



Join the Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation as it launches its new "Shop, Dine & Shuttle" program on Sunday, December 13 from 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. to support local businesses along Kamehameha Highway in Pearl City and Aiea during the holiday season.

The free circulator shuttle program will feature two vehicles, including an open-air trolley and an mini-bus to take area residents and visitors from the Aloha Stadium Swap Meet to approximately a dozen shopping destinations along Kamehameha Highway.

Rides on the trolley and the mini-bus will be fun for participants as they can jump from location to location without the hassle of finding parking at the crowded shopping centers during the busy holiday shopping season. For added value, the program connects with the Aloha Stadium Swap Meet.

Major shopping centers participating include Pearlridge Center, Waimalu Shopping Center, Waiolu Shopping Center, Pearl City Shopping Center, Pearl Highlands Center, Pearl Kai Center, and many more.

Rides on both shuttles will be free for passengers, and will be based upon seating availability. In addition, HART's "Shop & Dine on the Line" brochures that feature discounts from

100+ stores, restaurants and services will be passed out to shuttle riders.

The "Shop, Dine & Shuttle" program is presented by HART and its transportation partners, which include Move Oahu Forward and E Noa Tours.

H-1 FREEWAY WAIAWA INTERCHANGE

Farrington Highway and Kamehameha Highway near Waiawa Road

- The eastbound onramp from Waihona Street to Kamehameha Highway eastbound will be closed 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday, December 6 through Thursday, December 10.
- The westbound lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed between Kamehameha Highway and the Farrington Highway overpass at the H-1/H-2 merge 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday.
- DRIVERS SHOULD TAKE THE H-1 FREEWAY WEST TO THE WAIKELE EXIT, EXIT 7, AND LOOP BACK EAST TO ACCESS FARRINGTON HIGHWAY, KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY AND THE H-1 FREEWAY.

H-1 Freeway Waipahu off-ramp

- Westbound Waipahu off-ramp closed 9 p.m. to 4 a.m. nightly.

Farrington Highway near Leeward Community College entrance

- Up to three outside lanes of the H-1 Freeway westbound will be closed from 9 p.m. to 4 a.m.
- Up to three outside lanes of the H-1 Freeway eastbound will be closed from 8 p.m. to 4 a.m.
- The Farrington Highway eastbound on-ramp to the H-1 Freeway eastbound will be closed Sunday through Thursday from 9 p.m. to 4 a.m.

WAIPAHU (FARRINGTON HIGHWAY)

Old Fort Weaver Road to Leoku Street

- The inside lane of Farrington Highway will be closed from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Leoku Street to Leokane Street

- The inside lane of Farrington Highway closed 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. weekdays and

Saturdays as needed.

- The outside lane of westbound Farrington Highway closed from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. weekdays and Saturdays as needed.
- Left turn from Farrington Highway westbound at Leoku Street will be closed 24/7. U-turn available west side of Fort Weaver Road.
- Eastbound lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. U-turns available at Pupukahi Street for eastbound drivers and west of Fort Weaver Road for westbound motorists.

Aniani Place to Waipahu Depot Street

- Inside lane of Farrington Highway will be closed from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Westbound lanes of Farrington Highway closed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured to an eastbound lane.
- Inside lane of westbound Farrington Highway will be closed from 7 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. the next day. This lane will be open during afternoon peak travel times, between 3:30 p.m. and 7 p.m.

Waipahu Depot Street to Mokuola Street

- The inside lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Westbound lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured to Kikimoe Street.

Mokuola Street to Paiwa Street

- The inside lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Left turns at Paiwa Street will be closed 24/7. Detours available at Kahualii Street and Mokuola Street

Paiwa Street to Kahualii Street

- Eastbound lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured to Paiwa Street.
- Inside lanes of Farrington highway will be closed from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Outside lane of eastbound Farrington Highway will be closed between Kahualii Street and Kamehameha Highway overpass from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

PEARL CITY (KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY)

Waiawa Road to Acacia Road

- One straight-through eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed 24/7.
- One westbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Two westbound left turn lanes and a single inside lane westbound will be closed 24/7. Two through lanes will remain open.

Acacia Road to Waimano Home Road

- One straight-through lane of Kamehameha Highway in both directions and one left-turn lane in each direction onto Waimano Home Road and Lehua Avenue closed 24/7.
- One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed from 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- One westbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Waimano Home Road to Puu Momi Street

- Inside eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed 24/7
- One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

- One westbound lane will be closed 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.

Puu Momi Street to Puu Poni Street

- Inside eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed 24/7.

Puu Poni Street to Kuleana Road

- Inside eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed 24/7
- One westbound lane closed overnight between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.
- One eastbound lane closed 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- One west bound lane closed 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Kuleana Road to Kaahumanu Street

- One inside lane of Kamehameha Highway eastbound and one inside lane westbound will be closed 24/7.
- One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed from 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- One westbound lane will be closed 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- The eastbound left turn at Kaahumanu Street will be temporarily closed. Eastbound motorists will be detoured to Kuleana Road and Hekaha Street.

Kaahumanu Street and Hekaha Street :

- Single inside lane on eastbound direction, and a single lane in the westbound direction of Kamehameha Highway will be closed 24/7.
- Westbound left turn at Kaahumanu Street will be closed. Motorists will be detoured to Kuleana Road.

Kanuku Street to Kaonohi Street

- One inside lane of Kamehameha Highway eastbound and one inside lane in the westbound direction will be closed 24/7 between.
- One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed from 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
- One westbound lane will be closed 8 p.m. to 7 a.m..

AIEA/ALOHA STADIUM (KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY)

Lipoa Place to Pali Momi Street

- Two westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- Two eastbound lanes closed between 7 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.
- One westbound lane will be closed from 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Pali Momi Street to Honomanu Street

- Two westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- Two eastbound lanes closed between 7 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Near Aloha Stadium -Honomanu Street to Salt Lake Boulevard

- The Kamehameha Highway westbound on-ramp to the Moanalua Freeway will be closed 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday night through Thursday.
- Up to three westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m.

- Two eastbound lanes closed between 7 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.
- Up to three westbound lanes of Salt Lake Boulevard will be closed from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Monday through Thursday, eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be crossed over to the westbound lanes between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.

PEARL HARBOR/AIRPORT

NOTE: There will be no work in the Pearl Harbor/ Airport area on Monday, December 7, to accommodate events at Pearl Harbor

Kamehameha Highway from Center Drive to Radford Drive

- Two westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.; right turn allowed at the intersection.
- The right turn lane only lane may be closed between 8 a.m. and 2:30p.m.
- The left turn only lane into Makalapa Gate is contraflowed in the eastbound direction between 8 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.
- Kamehameha Highway from Radford Drive to Halawa Drive
Two lanes of Kamehameha Highway may be closed 8 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. with traffic contraflowed to the eastbound lane just beyond the Radford intersection.
- The westbound bus stop at Radford Drive may be temporarily relocated closer to the intersection between 8 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.
- One lane of Kamehameha Highway may be closed between 8 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. approaching Halawa Drive.

Kamehameha Highway from Ford Island Bridge to Arizona Memorial Place

- One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway may be closed between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Kamehameha Highway from Arizona Memorial Place to Arizona Street

- One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Kamehameha Highway from Arizona Street to Makalapa Road/Gate

- Two eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Kamehameha Highway from Makalapa Road to Center Drive

- One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
- Eastbound bus stop at Kamehameha Highway and Makalapa Rd. may be temporarily relocated to mid-block between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Makai Frontage Road/Nimitz Hwy Eastbound from Kamehameha Highway/Plantation Drive to H-1/Valkenburgh Street/Hickam AFB

- Single eastbound lane approaching H-1/ Nimitz Highway closed between 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.
- Single eastbound right lane approaching Hickam AFB may be closed between 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.

Aolele Street from Aolewa Place to Lagoon Drive

Single westbound lane is closed between 8:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
