

TRAFFIC UPDATE - Farrington Highway

Week of August 19, 2018

There will be no daytime lane closures Monday, August 20 to Friday, August 24 for the annual University of Hawaii "Back To School Jam," unless HART permits a variance where noted. All 24/7 closures currently in place will remain during this time.

KAPOLEI

Sunday, August 19, 2018 to Saturday, August 25, 2018

LOCATION: Kualaka'i Parkway at Keahumoa Parkway

24 Hours a Day, Seven Days a Week

The outside lanes of eastbound and westbound Keahumoa Parkway will be closed. The westbound sidewalk will also be closed. Pedestrians will be detoured to the eastbound sidewalk. A minimum of one lane in each direction will be open.

Nighttime: 8:30 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., overnights Monday to Friday

One lane of Keahumoa Parkway will be closed. On-site flaggers will be controlling traffic in remaining lane.

Note: Due to overhead crane work, traffic may be stopped intermittently for no more than 5 minutes due to safety for commuters and pedestrians.

WAIPAHU

Sunday, August 19, 2018 to Saturday, August 25, 2018

LOCATION: Moloalo Street between Mokuola Street and Sherwin Williams

24 Hours a Day, Seven Days a Week

The area fronting the station site along Moloalo Street will be closed.

Shoulder and median work signage/cones along the side of the road will mark the work area. Motorists are advised to drive with caution and provide a safe distance between themselves, the construction workers and vehicles. *Lane closures are subject to change.

Please be advised that intermittent, roving lane closures along Farrington Highway may be necessary for maintenance.
