Two eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed. Bus stop will be relocated as needed. Pedestrian access will be maintained.

IWILEI

LOCATION: Kaaahi Street between Dillingham Boulevard and Kaaahi Place

Daytime: 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday

No on-street parking will be allowed. On-Street parking will be allowed on Thanksgiving Day, Thursday, November 22, 2018.

KAKAAKO

LOCATION: Halekauwila Street between Keawe Street and Coral Street

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Wednesday

Alternating lanes eastbound and westbound on Halekauwila Street may be closed.

LOCATION: Halekauwila Street Intersection

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Wednesday

Eastbound and westbound lanes of Halekauwila Street will be closed at the Keawe Intersection. Motorists will be detoured northbound or southbound at South Street and northbound or southbound at Cooke Street.

LOCATION: Keawe Street Intersection

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Wednesday

Northbound and southbound lanes of Keawe Street will be closed at the Halekauwila Intersection. Motorists will be detoured eastbound or westbound at Pohukaina Street and eastbound or westbound at Queen Street.
