Hi Susan and Beth,

Per the e-mail below, Alex Keenan with the Senate Approps Committee would like to know the status of the Honolulu Project. If I have my facts straight I think the status is as follows:

O We extended the final Environmental Impact Statement review/comment period from Aug. 16 to Aug. 26 - so the comment period will close later this week on the FEIS. Do we anticipate issuing the ROD soon after or is that still up in the air?

O From the recent letter to the Gov, we say that we don't expect FD approval until Feb or March 2011. Is that because it will likely take them that long to prepare the FD documentation or does it also have to do with timing of the ROD?

O With respect to Alex's question about FY 12 funding. Obviously we can't comment on what our FY 2012 request will be since that is not public (and we might not yet know). But is there any general info we can say about their funding need in FY 2012? Do we know yet what they are seeking in 2012? Thanks!
